- ❖ Week 7: "The Future Looks Great!"

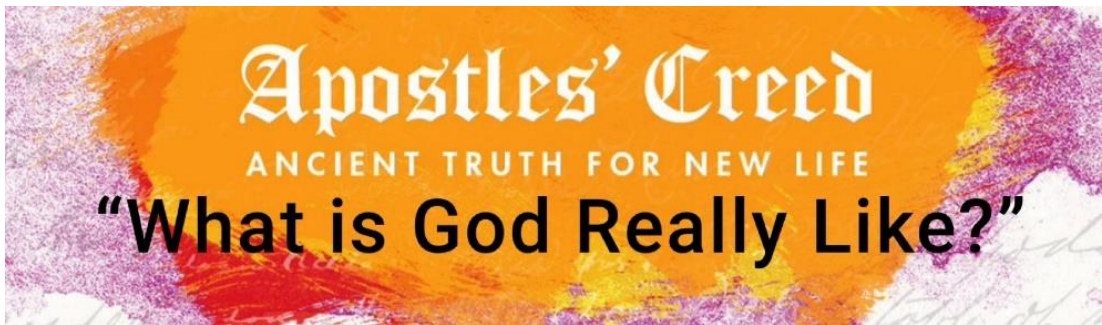
