Dear friends and faithful partners in ministry, Many years of government instability,

corruption, and frequent natural disasters have taken a toll on Haiti's economy and infrastructure. The last 2 years of protests, drought, and now COVID-19, have been extremely difficult. The Wesleyan Mission has struggled financially due to the reduced number of teams, and our reserves were quickly depleted. We have been able to keep our essential mission employees paid due to the sacrifice and generosity of financial partners who have given one time and monthly gifts during this time. The Mission now faces another challenge, and we need your financial help. The Mission Station that supports the La Gonave Mission Hospital will be losing its source of electricity in less than a month, and we need to raise \$55,000 to install batteries and solar panels as soon as possible. The new system will provide power throughout the

day and night for our hospital and missionaries who live there. We believe that God will supply our need. Would you prayerfully consider how you can help us reach our goal? Sincerely, Greg Edmonds, Haiti Mission Director
