EASTER 2015 ATTENDANCE, CONVERSIONS, AND BAPTISMS SET RECORDS: The 2015

Easter attendance in Wesleyan Churches in the USA and Canada set new records. New highs were also reached in conversions and baptisms. U.S. and Canada attendance totals were **380,645**, including **6,708** conversions and **804** baptisms. Here in the N.C. West District, we had **11,681** in attendance, **43** known conversions, and **35** baptisms.

While the above figures are a reason to be encouraged, a report was also released this week by the Pew Research Center which gives us cause for concern. A new study by the PRC shows a sharp drop in the number of American Christians -- from 78% of the population to 71% in seven years-- mainly because millennials are leaving the fold. Just 56% of millennials consider themselves Christians.

Meanwhile, religiously unaffiliated Americans -- often called the "nones" -- form nearly 23% of the population, a greater percentage than Catholics and mainline Protestants. Pew's study comes from a survey of 35,000 American adults and is generally considered one of the most accurate reflections of the country's religious landscape.
